of the South Park Township**

Board of Supervisors

May 10, 2021

Pledge of Allegiance

Roll Call

Walt Sackinsky presiding. Board members Edward Snee and Brian Lucot were present. Also in attendance were Karen Fosbaugh, Township Manager; Irv Firman, Solicitor; Dennis McDonough, Chief of Police; Tom Bonidie, Code Enforcement Officer; and Aaron Laughlin, Director of Public Works.

Fosbaugh stated for the record that no emails or comments were received and there are no call-in comments.

Mr. Sackinsky informed the audience that since COVID-19 restrictions are being eased at the end of the month, the June 14th Board of Supervisors meeting will be the last meeting utilizing the phone call-in comments.

Presentation of Proclamation - Designating May 16-22, 2021 as Emergency Medical Services Week

Mr. Lucot recognized the following EMS members: EMS Director Nora Helfrich, John Bower, Gary Muetzel, Maureen Evans, David Trombetta, Rick Palano and Tim Snyder. He read aloud the Proclamation, which designated May 16-22, 2021, as Emergency Medical Services Week, and recognized the quality of services provided by the Tri-Community South EMS to South Park Township and the entire South Hills Community. Afterward, pictures were taken.

Presentation of Proclamation – Designating May 9-15, 2021 as National Police Week

Mr. Snee read aloud the Proclamation, which designated May 9-15, 2021, as National Police Week, and recognized the South Park Township Police Department’s dedication to serving the community by preserving the rights and security of all citizens. Afterward, pictures were taken.

Action on Grinder Pump Agreement – 2013 Pinnacle Way – South Park Township and NVR Inc. of Pittsburgh

Motion by Mr. Snee, seconded by Mr. Lucot, to approve the Grinder Pump Agreement by and between NVR Inc. of Pittsburgh and South Park Township, the purpose of which is to outline the terms and conditions regarding the installation of a grinder pump at 2013 Pinnacle Way, and further clarifying the Owner, NVR Inc, and all successors and assigns, being Donald and Elizabeth Ossler, shall be solely responsible for the purchase, installation, maintenance activities, related costs, liability of the Grinder Pump System, and the connection of same to the Township’s public sanitary sewer system, and authorizing the appropriate Township official to execute said Agreement which shall be subsequently recorded

at the Recorder of Deeds Office by the Township. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

Action on Non-Exclusive License Agreement – 3629 Falmouth Drive – Wayne and Stephanie Betz

Motion by Mr. Snee, seconded by Mr. Lucot, to approve the Non-Exclusive License Agreement by and between the Township of South Park (Grantor), and Wayne and Stephanie Betz (Grantees), to permit the construction of a 20' x 12' deck over a sanitary sewer easement located on Lot No. 126 of the Village of Knothole Plan No. 1, Lot & Block No. 1008-S-40, being 3629 Falmouth Drive, as recommended by the Director of Public Works, and further authorized the appropriate Township officials to execute said Agreement. The Grantee(s) are to understand and acknowledge that by executing the Agreement, they agree that South Park Township has the right to access the easement for repair and/or maintenance purposes. The Grantee(s) further understand and acknowledge that access to the easement by South Park Township may necessitate the removal of the encroachment by the Grantee(s) at their cost, and that South Park Township will not be responsible for any and all repairs, damages or replacement of said encroachment. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

Action on Non-Exclusive License Agreement – 5023 Summit Drive – Eric and Faith Attanucci

Motion by Mr. Snee, seconded by Mr. Lucot, to approve the Non-Exclusive License Agreement by and between the Township of South Park (Grantor) and Eric and Faith Attanucci (Grantees), to permit the construction of a four-foot (4') fence over a storm sewer easement located on Lot No. 17 of the Summit Station Phase 1 Subdivision, Lot & Block No. 887-S-98, being 5023 Summit Drive, as recommended by the Director of Public Works, and further authorized the appropriate Township officials to execute said Agreement. The Grantee(s) are to understand and acknowledge that by executing the Agreement, they agree that South Park Township has the right to access the easement for repair and/or maintenance purposes. The Grantee(s) further understand and acknowledge that access to the easement by South Park Township may necessitate the removal of the encroachment by the Grantee(s) at their cost, and that South Park Township will not be responsible for any and all repairs, damages or replacement of said encroachment. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

The Grantee(s) are to understand and acknowledge that by executing the Agreement, they agree that South Park Township has the right to access the easement for repair and/or maintenance purposes. The Grantee(s)

further understand and acknowledge that access to the easement by South Park Township may necessitate the removal of the encroachment by the Grantee(s) at their cost, and that South Park Township will not be responsible for any and all repairs, damages or replacement of said encroachment. Motion by Mr. Snee, seconded by Mr. Lucot, to approve the participation of Code Enforcement Officer/Building Code Official Tom Bonidie in a training session entitled, “RA 401: Residential Mechanical Academy,” sponsored by the Pennsylvania Construction Codes Academy (PCCA), which involves both live and video on-line instruction, at a total cost to the Township of \$395.00. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

Action on Conference Attendance – Township Supervisor Edward Snee

Motion by Mr. Lucot, seconded by Mr. Sackinsky, to authorize the attendance of Township Supervisor Edward Snee to the 2021 Spring Educational Conference sponsored by the Allegheny League of Municipalities (ALOM), scheduled for June 17-20, 2021, which will be held at Seven Springs, PA, at a total cost to the Township of \$1,006.00. Mr. Snee abstained. Motion carried.

Action on MS4 Report

Mrs. Fosbaugh stated that the following is the MS4 Report for April, dated May 10, 2021. She explained that MS4 is an acronym for Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System, and municipalities in Pennsylvania are under this mandate to prevent and maintain the integrity of fresh water streams.

1. The part-time litter collection employee continued with his duties on Township streets to prevent trash from impacting the function of the stormwater inlets.
2. The Public Works Department rebuilt five inlets in April.
3. The Administrative Assistant and the Local Government Academy intern have been scanning existing sanitary sewer tap-in drawings into the Environmental Systems Research Institute (ESRI) data base for easy reference. At this time, 4,400+ homes have been scanned into the system. This equates to 170+ streets, with approximately 30 streets remaining. The annual inlet inspection continues, with 565 inlets out of 1,157 inspected to date. The inlet inspections have been added to the ESRI data base for tracking purposes.
4. Jet Jack, Inc., the contractor for the 2021 Township-Wide Sanitary Sewer Program, began the contract work mid-April. Included in the project scope is approximately 250 l.ft. of 15” storm sewer line in the vicinity of Ridge Road. The line has been televised and cleaned in preparation of the relining process.

The repair work on the storm sewer line coming from Jack Pine Drive has been completed. However, the relining component of the project, which is 200 feet of storm sewer, will be completed by the contractor this week, weather permitting.

5. All new developments are conforming with the Stormwater Management Ordinance relative to erosion and sedimentation controls. The Township Engineer is conducting the inspections to ensure that developers adhere to the appropriate guidelines which help maintain water quality.

6. Final details were provided to Allegheny County regarding Community Development Year 47. The Township is awaiting the determination of a grant application in the amount of \$27,000 for the repair of a sanitary sewer line in the vicinity of Highland Avenue, Grant Street and Victory Drive. The total project cost is estimated to be \$41,580.00.

7. Union Township utilized the services of Harshmann LLC to design a new sanitary sewer line system to service 24 lots which replaced a number of failing septic systems on Rt. 88/Library Road and Overlook Street. The project is in the final stages of completion and will protect the fresh water supply in both South Park Township and Union Township. The project has been in the planning and design phase for 6+ years.

Motion by Mr. Snee, seconded by Mr. Lucot, to approve the MS4 Report for the month of April, 2021. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

Chief McDonough commented that during the Township Environmental Day on April 24th, the Police Department collected 186 pounds of unwanted prescription drugs, which were turned over to the DEA for disposal.

Chief McDonough also remarked that at their joint venture with the Sheriff's Department on May 1st, for the Satellite License to Carry Event

held in the Township Community Center, 962 permits were issued by the Sheriff's Department.

Motion by Mr. Snee, seconded by Mr. Lucot, to accept the Police Chief's report for the month of April, 2021. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

**Supervisors'
Comments**

Mr. Lucot – Mr. Lucot thanked everyone for attending. He expressed his appreciation to Nora Helfrich and the EMS members, Chief McDonough and the Police Department, and Mr. Laughlin and the public works employees, for all their hard work. Mr. Lucot commented that the Satellite License to Carry Event was run very well by the Sheriff's Office.

Mr. Snee – Mr. Snee recognized EMS, the Police Department and the Public Works Department for their dedication to the community. He mentioned that the Township Environmental Day was very well attended. Mr. Snee expressed his appreciation to Mrs. Fosbaugh for her hard work in obtaining a \$71,000 grant for the proposed restrooms at Evans Park towards the total cost of \$169,000. Mrs. Fosbaugh also was able to obtain a grant for \$200,000 for the proposed upgrades to the Route 88 and Brownsville Road intersection, which total approximately \$1.3 million. The developer of Summit Station has also contributed \$345,000 toward the improvement of the intersection. Mrs. Fosbaugh is currently seeking other grant opportunities for the upgrades. She is also currently working on a Multimodal Grant, and a Demolition Grant. Mr. Snee, again, thanked Mrs. Fosbaugh for her time and dedication and asked for a round of applause.

Mr. Sackinsky – Mr. Sackinsky had no comments.

Adjournment

Motion by Mr. Lucot, seconded Mr. Sackinsky to adjourn the meeting. All members voted aye. Motion carried.
